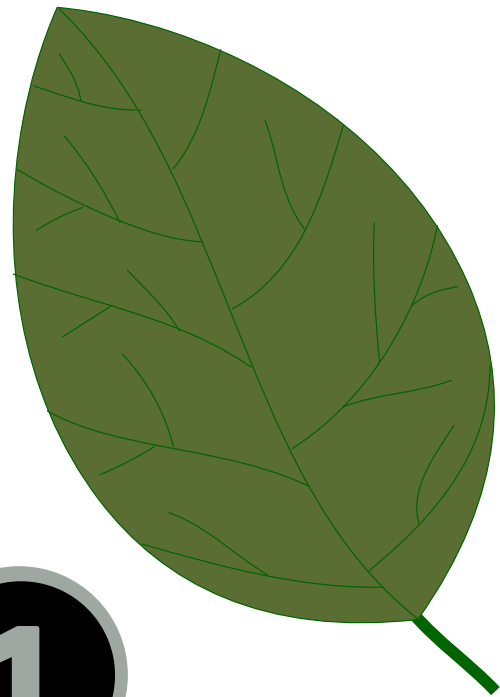

- Add a few drops of water to the green paint disc to soften the pigment.
- Load a small round brush with pigment
- Paint the outline of a oval shaped leaf tucked up near to a blossom.
- Fill in the leaf with paint.

- Using a scratch stick or the end of the paint brush - draw the center line of the leaf and its veins.

Scratching into paper which is damp from the paint will break the paper fibers and allow paint to "pool" in the marks that you make.

- Fill the spaces between your flowers with textured leaves.
- Allow some leaves to venture outside of your circle for added interest.

- Sign your name to your painting and show off your painting to your family and friends!
